#### POLICY ON SATURDAY DRESS CODE

Effective Date: 15th January 2025

To promote a professional and comfortable environment, the following policy outlines the dress code for Saturdays at ALIMS School of Business:

#### 1. General Guidelines:

- The mandatory wearing of the full set suit is not required in Saturdays.
- Staff and students are permitted to wear decent casual attire.

#### 2. Permitted Attire:

- o Any attire that is torn, excessively tight, or revealing.

### 4. Special Occasions:

- If there is a pre-determined official program or event scheduled on a Saturday, all staff and students are required to wear their full set suit, as on regular working days.
- Notification of such events will be provided in advance.

## 5. **Compliance:**

All staff and students are expected to adhere to this dress code policy.
 Failure to comply with the dress code may result in appropriate disciplinary action, as outlined in the institute's rules and regulations.
